I want to normalize. And that's because this is what we do in our community. It's so tight over here. Okay, wait, calm down. Janice, breathe. It is so amazing over here that I, I don't know what it's like and I don't want to know what it's like. In other spaces and places that don't have what we have over here.



I mean, I, I kind of do, cause you know, before we had this, I've been in some spaces and places, but where we are with a significant life nation, that's what we call ourselves over here, where we show up, we know what it's like to be seen, celebrated and fully supported. Can you say that scene? They see me, they see you, girl.

They see you not just show good stuff. They see the raw stuff. But you still celebrate it. Even when I see you undone, even when I see your uncomely parts, I see you and I celebrate you. And in this space, you are fully supported. Listen, can we normalize that? Can we just normalize being seen, celebrated, and fully supported so that we can rise and soar to our next level?

Y'all ready for this? With no strings attached. Yeah, this is, this is with no strings attached. I see you, I celebrate you, I support you, and I don't want nothing from you. I'm not competing with you. That, that's what we have over here. So let's talk about why women join this community. Why do they come over here?

Why? Why am I their mentor coach? Why is this their, their people? Let's talk about it because here over here in significant life, what we do is we experience exponential, abnormal breakthrough and breakout success so that we can soar into our next level, the next dimension of our success and our progress in every area of our lives.

Yeah, that, that, when God gave me this vision and this mission for significant life, what was important to me is that the life that I live didn't just work. at church. It didn't just work in my business, but in every aspect, in every place where I showed up, if I'm going to live with him, live for him and with him, dog on the Lord, can it work in my marriage?

Can it work with my children? Can it work in my health? Can it work in all my endeavors? Not just in my church work. Y'all, y'all, y'all don't want to hear me right now because sometimes, you know, we have these spiritual, we're guided by these spiritual principles and these this spiritual awakening and the spiritual awareness.

And it only works in spiritual settings. That's because I'm not, I'm not going to go here on this one. Oftentimes we disconnect the fullness of our spirituality and what it is meant to do for who we are and what is meant to provide us to, um, from how we show up in other aspects of our life. So we only get the benefits when we're at church.

We only get the benefits when we're doing work for God. For God and not when, as we do life with him, because when you're doing life with him, every aspect of your life should be working. That does not mean there are no problems. That doesn't mean we don't have challenges. That don't mean we don't have obstacles.

Jesus himself said in this world, you will have trouble. Hello, but be of good cheer. Because I will become the world. Okay. Stay focused. Janice. So by the way, I'm Janice Anderson, Christian women, leaders, founders, executives, business leaders, and ministry leaders. They come to me when they're navigating seasons of transition, bouncing back from setback, or when they're looking for strength and strategy for their next step.



season of life or their current season of life. And through our work together and this amazing community that, um, I have the awesome honor to walk alongside and to Stuart, these women are able to live and enjoy their significant life instead of a life that they're striving for or settling for. And I'm so happy.

So let's now dive into these top three reasons why busy women of power and influence choose this community amongst all the other things they could be doing and in the midst of what they're already doing. Y'all ready? Okay. I have a little story I want to share, but guess what? I'm not going to be the one telling the story.

I had a conversation with one of my clients, Tamika, and I'm just going to let her share her experience. So listen to what Tamika has to say.

The weight of what I do gets lost at being good at what I do. People don't realize what it costs us. And so one of the things, you know, acknowledging that this is my life and it's okay. It's my life and it's okay to this my life. I just need to best steward my life. It's not ideal. But it can be better, you know, and I'm in a lot of places where I'm giving more than I'm receiving.

And so that is what made this most refreshing because I can still show up as myself. I don't hit the mute or dilute myself and I can be supported, you know, in my limits and my limitations. And I feel like it's holistic and, and we're with other sisters that understand. Yeah. And so I really, really need this because I can tell I had enough to hold me and I had a good framework for what I did, where I can apply that stuff, but I need something continually because when I go to church, you know, I receive, but it's not in proportion to what I get.

And I usually try to keep at least one space in my life. That I own, and this has been that space. Wow. Listen, how many of you, when you listen to that, you can relate to what she's saying? I just need a space that belongs to me. I need a place where I can be the fullness of who I am. Because although I'm good at what I do, It doesn't mean it's easy for me to be the woman that I am.

And it cost me, like, I could resonate y'all. I was writing so feverishly. I couldn't show y'all the raw form of that because during that call, it was actually one of our coaching calls. And, um, We both look like not camera ready. And so I decided not to show our faces, but I was writing so many notes because what she shared just echoed in so many words, what many of the ladies that come into our community and our space they say.



And, um, I'll just go ahead and start here with the top of the top three reasons. Reason number three, that women join this community that they come into this sacred space is because of community. I mean, listen, we've heard many times it's lonely at the top. First of all, I hate that. It doesn't have to be lonely at the top.

Most of the time, we make it lonely at the top. But there's a little truth in there, and the truth is this. Oftentimes, if we are not open, if we are not I'm just going to put it out here. Healed in the way that we need to be healed. If our heart isn't healed, then, and we're not receptive, we miss the opportunity to connect with others that are like us.

And so while it, why it, the reason it feels lonely at the top is because we're at the top trying to stay in close, connection and intimacy with people who don't understand us, who don't get us and, and who are not like us and who, who haven't made the decisions that we've made. And so one of the reasons, reason number three, that women join this community, especially busy high performing women, they join this community is because it's a safe and sacred life giving community.

It's a safe community, it's a sacred community, but it also is a life giving community. I started researching when I was thinking about what would I say if I could only give three things to talk about what happens here at Significant Life. I was like, okay, how could I say it and capture all the testimonials and all the stories that the ladies have shared and the things that I've witnessed?

And one of the definitions that came up is the true essence of what a community is. In a community, by definition, it's a fellowship with others as a result of sharing three things. Common attitudes, common interests, and common goals. Common attitudes, common interests, and common goals. So a true community in the essence of the word community is not just because we all in the same space, we all in the same room, we're all in proximity, that doesn't make us community.

And you know, like I know all circles and all communities are not life giving all circles, all communities. They don't give me life. I'm in some circles. I'd be around some circles. I listen, I double dutch in some circles by nature. I have to like my blood circle. Yeah. Listen, y'all ain't got to say it. I'm gonna say it.

I'm the one that got the mic right now. You know, some things you get to, he's like, I, I was born here. That don't mean it's life giving and not all high performers are, are the same. We don't all roll the same. We don't all show up the same. Some people perform at a high level in our tricky as all get out.

Integrity is not a core value for them. Winning is. You know, and, and not all sacred spaces. And I hate to say this, but it is the truth. Not all sacred spaces are safe. So one of the reasons why women come to this space is because it is those things. It is safe. They are with women who have like attitudes, like goals and like interests.



We don't think they're too much cause we're the same. We all too much. We don't think they're too smart, too nerdy and doing and going over the top because we're all over the top. We're all nerdy. We're all digging in. We're all, we're all relentless and diligent about the things that we do. We don't think that we're too holy and too spiritual.

We all are. So number three reason why people join this community is because of community and because it's a safe and sacred and it's a life giving community. And I want to say this about the word sacred because one of the tenants of a significant life and a woman who is living her significant life is that she has within her a sacred self perception.

I'll talk more about that later on in our conversation today, but sacred means worthy of all and respect. This is a community that's worthy of all and respect. Not because I'm so great, not because I'm so great and I'm a dog on great chick. Let me hear y'all. Let me listen. Listen, I'd be doing a dog on thing, but it's not because of me.

It's because of who and what makes up this community. You know, literally, um, by nature, and I wasn't even going here today, but, um, there's a scripture that says that we are fearfully and wonderfully made, and I, in Psalm 139. And fearfully means worthy of all. No, wait, wait, let me say, now y'all gonna make me pull out my notes.

I wasn't trying to do that today. I wasn't trying to do that today, but I guess I'm, I guess I am doing that today. Let me, let me just read it. Why do you have it in your note stand is because I was praying it over my husband. And as I was praying it over my husband and praying about What I want him to remember about the man that he is and who God called him to be.

I wanted him to anchor in God. You made him fearfully and wonderfully. And as I was praying that, let me just, let me, I started looking up cause y'all know, we read some words, we say some words. We don't even know what the definition is, but in that verse, That's in Psalm, so it's in Hebrew. In Hebrew, that word fearfully means to cause astonishment and awe, a glorious work of Yahweh.

The community is a sacred community because it's made up of women that are fearfully and wonderfully made. It's made up of sacred beings. Okay. Wonderfully means to be separate and distinct. We talked about that. I'm not going to talk about that on this, on this lab right here, but I just want you to know that's what makes it a community is worthy of respect because you are worthy of respect.

And I'm not even on that one right now. And in this space, we embody that, we live that, we show up as that. Reason number two. The second reason that women who are busy, high performing women who lead and women of influence, women who others are looking to come to this space is because of accountability.

Now the leaders in our significant life community, they are ones who, um, often are the answers. They're the go to women in their circles and in their sphere of influence. They are the



answers. They got the answers. Y'all, they make the rules. And they enforce the rules. I mean, think about it. Are you the one that's coming up with the rules?

Are you, are you coming up with the way things go? Do people call you to say, Hey, what do you think about this? Have you considered this? They got the answers. And oftentimes they are the answer. Not because they are headstrong, ego driven, control freaks. No, I want you to hear me out. It's not because they, we are these stubborn women.

I'm saying they like this, like I'm not a part of it. I am a part of it. And it's not because we're the answers and we have the answers, not because we're here strong or we ego driven or we control freaks. Nope. I get the awesome honor and privilege to work alongside women. just like me, who are women of access, women of authority.

And these women have access. They have authority because they are women under authority. And for all my Bible readers, you've heard that phraseology before. I understand authority because I am a person under authority. These are women who can be trusted with precious things, with priceless matters and with unprecedented power.

And I'm going to say this one more time because these are women of authority and women who are submitted to the highest authority. They're not running rogue or reckless and how they live their lives and how they show up in various aspects of their life, whether it's their relationship with their money in their own life and their health and their wellness, their careers.

No, they are women who honors their commitment to their call. We honor our commitment to our community. We honor our commitment to ourselves. And we honor and take very, very seriously the relational commitment to the Lord of the call, the Lord of our community and the Lord of our lives. So accountability is important to these women because it is easy to get sucked into the weight of doing the work.

It's easy to get sucked into the weight of making sure it's done. It's easy to get sucked in that you forget that sometimes that you forget, Oh, wait a minute, above what I do is who I am above the work is the God of the work. And so the accountability, it helps us to stay true to our ultimate responsibility.

And we do that here in a very structured and very real manner. Here, um, we know we, we are principle centered in our approach to how we show up in this community and how we, we support one another and how I and my team support the ladies in our community. There are four levels of accountability that, um, exist and we have incorporated all four.

Four of those levels within our community and the work that we provide and how we teach, how we train, how we facilitate, how I mentor and how our coach, it is all built into that. And that was one of the things the ladies were looking for because often because they are the go to person, sometimes it's easy to get that, who going to check me boo syndrome.



So who will check me boo? I mean, I'm sorry. I forgot to tell y'all. Did y'all realize how I am and who I am? So every now and then it could be that, or some people don't feel qualified. And quite honestly, can I, can I say this? Some people aren't qualified to speak to where you are and what you're doing.

Cause one, they haven't put the work in that. They're not even, actively and diligently pursuing the next level of the highest level in their own lives, in their own spirituality, in their own work, in their own walk. So then how then can they say something to you or hold you accountable or hold a light and a standard in front of you when they're not living up to no standards, stay focused.

But in this space, we all are living up to that. We're living according to the highest standard. And as we set our goals for our life, for our call, for our mission, and for the aspects of our life that are important to us, accountability is important. And the final reason I'm so excited. I love this reason.

And this reason often is a reason that women struggle to articulate. But once we get into our work together, or maybe after a session or two, um, either whether it's through the life class or, um, Um, maybe an anchored prayer session, or even if it's a mentor coaching session, hands down, um, it never fails.

Women come to this point and the number one reason that women join and become a part of this significant life community is to go deeper in this journey of self discovery. The women in this sacred space, They are record breaking women. They are trailblazers and innovators. These are women of wisdom and impeccable insight.

Like, I, I can't even really show you the depth of what these women do and who they are. Even when I sit in, into it and I just kind of sit back and I reflect, Um, on who I get to walk alongside and who I meet and what God has placed on the inside of these women who are doing phenomenal things that blow my mind.

I am so, um, in at all and honored and humbled to walk alongside them and to be given, um, this amazing opportunity to steward. This them for however long and, and help them to see, you know, one of the things when you, when you are a seer and you can see, hello, all the seers out there, raise your hand. That's me.

And you can see one of the beautiful gifts that I have. Um, and I thank God for entrusting me with the ability to see, I see what they can't see and they are seeing a lot of things. But I see what they can't see about who they are and who they're called to be. I see what they can't see about the problems and challenges that they're facing and the people that are in their lives and the, and the, the issues that are before them.



They think it's a job. I see that it's a territorial assignment. You know, they think that it is, you know, um, opposition and I see that it is a maturing ground for them. They think. That it is them proving that God is calling them to show this unconditional love, and I can see that they are climbing a mountain that God has given them permission to walk around, and even greater, to speak to and cause to move.

It is such a beautiful and honorable, uh, life assignment that I get to do with the women in this community. And I wouldn't trade it for anything in the world. And one of the things that I get to see about these women on this journey of their own self discovery. I noticed that I recognized it because doggone it, I've been them in many cases and I too am still on my own journey.

I just happened to be a different phase than what many of them are when they come. And so what happens is you can be this phenomenal, amazing woman doing these impeccable things. A woman of wisdom, a woman of insight, a woman of wealth, a woman who is making trailblazing and is innovative and yet It is hard to see yourself beyond your roles and responsibilities.

So in this space, in this sacred space, this life giving space, they get to go on this journey of self discovering where they can see themselves beyond their roles and responsibilities. Cause here's what happens. When, when all the only way you see yourself is based on what I do and based on who needs me and based on what I'm responsible for.

When life happens and a shakeup occurs, you find yourself fighting and scrambling to embrace the full essence of who you are. You find yourself second guessing from everything about yourself, disconnecting from things and people and places and assignments and, and, um, and, and declarations of your identity.

You disconnect from it cause life done happen. And this is contradictory. This evidence doesn't match who I thought that I was. Cause if I, if I was her, This wouldn't happen if I was smarter, if I was sharper, if I was wiser, if I was more spiritual, if I was more in tune, this wouldn't happen. And that's such a lie.

So I love the opportunity to walk alongside these ladies on this journey because what I see happen is many women when life happens, when the shakeup occurs, they begin to search outwardly for clues and indications of their identity. This is what came up to me when I was thinking about that. Listen to this.

Hope I don't get muted. I can't play it that long. But listen to this right here. Hold on.

They start searching in spaces like their marriage and they start looking for themselves in their marriage. Like, Oh, I'm good. If my marriage is good. Oh, I'm good. If my ministry endeavors are good. Oh, I'm good. If my business is soaring, Oh, I'm worthy. I'm great. If my career expo are good. Oh my goodness.



I'm great. Cause I got a lot of money. I've crossed the seven figure mark. And they search for all of these places and these places. Always come up short because no amount of money, no amount of power, no amount of influence, no amount of makeup, no amount of handbags, no amount of luxury shopping trips or exclusive getaways with your girlfriend or your husband.

None of that quenches the longing of your heart and the cry of your heart to be sacred. To be that sacred version of you. Remember, let's go back to that sacred version. That sacred version is that that version of you is worthy of all and honor and respect that impenetrable version of yourself. And so in our time together, however long this thing.

We're peeling back layers. Yeah, we're getting things done. Yes, girl. We're accomplishing those goals. I mean, in our marriage, in our weight, in our money, in our businesses, we are doing a doggone thing and we take it everything to another notch level. But it's so much bigger than the things that we achieve is who we become in the process.

And this, are we that sacred and penetrable version of ourselves? And that to me, it's the number one reason why women connect with this community, why they come on this journey with me, this sacred journey. That's what I call it of discovering, embracing and living your significant life. Y'all know why the, the, the, the site, um, the link says live, lead and serve, because that's what happens when we're living our significant life.

We live, we lead And we serve from an anchored place, a place where our self perception is sacred, where our connections are life giving and where our contribution to this world is undeniable. That's what this is. So this is why people join and I, and I don't know if you've been on the fence. Maybe you're like you, maybe that's your first time even seeing me and you've been watching me and you've been staying on looking from afar trying to figure out, should I do it?

Uh, I know, I already know what she knows. You heard Tamika, this what she does. But in the spaces she goes in, you find yourself coming up short. I don't get as much as I give. And at some point when you don't get as much as you give, you become depleted. And so this is that space where you can be on if you need to be or if, if the space needs you to be, and you can be off as well.
